A	Original sin in the Garden of Eden	Genesis 3	Gen 3:14-19	Slide #2— Gen 3:15 & 19 Slide #3—verses on work
B	Evil thoughts of man at time of Noah	Slide #4— Genesis 6:5,11	Worldwide flood & destruction Shortening of lifespan (Gen 6:3 & Ps 90:10)	God's sign with a rainbow Jesus' words about the days of Noah Mt 24:37 & Lk 17:26
C	Jews flight from Egypt	Slide #5— God's provision Ex 12:35-36; Deut 29:5	People's complaints - Num 11:4; 14:22; Ps 78:1-41; 106:14 (Only two adults who entered the desert also entered Promised Land - Numbers 13:30)	Upon death of Moses, Joshua was appointed to lead Israelites into Promised Land by first crossing the River Jordan near Jericho
D	Jews want an earthly king	1 Samuel 8	1 Samuel 8:10-18	Isaiah's hopeful & prophetic messages concerning Israel's future (Chap 40-66)
E	New Testament Israel	Slide #6— Romans 9-11	Eyes veiled until midpoint of Daniel's 70th week	Slide #7—Escape from Man of Lawlessness (Matt 24:16-20; Rev 12:13-14; see also Zech 13:8-9)
F	New Testament Gentiles	Book of Acts, Paul's letters, etc.	Accept truth of Christ's coming, death & resurrection or be among those left behind at the rapture	Slide #8—One further opportunity for salvation but at the price of martyrdom / beheading (Rev 13:15; 20:4) Slide #9—Mercy triumphs over judgment
G	Final opportunity to repent via Two Witnesses of Revelation	Rev 11:3-12	Slide #10—Unrepentant man Rev 16:9,11,21 Great White Throne Judgment (Rev 20:11-15)	No further opportunity for unrepentant man; millennial reign with Christ for all His followers and eternity with Him
